As a non-profit ministry, we are dependant upon generous groups who provide for our mission to the unborn & their parents! There are many ways to help Grace House ! Hosting an event is a wonderful way in which to minister to people in crisis & promote sanctity of human life in your group or church. There are different types of events you can plan, but the best way to help us is a Baby Bottle Blessing Event.

BABY BOTTLE BLESSINGS

The Baby Bottle Blessing is a wonderful mission project for the entire family, church, or group such as Sunday School and Vacation Bible School. During this event new or used baby bottles are distributed to collect silver coins, bills, & checks to support this mission to the unborn & their parents. Each group or church that participates may collect their own new or used baby bottles, or Grace House can supply them.



Preparing & Giving out Bottles

Your leader will make copies of the contact sheet to cut the slips apart so that each baby bottle has a place for your donating members to supply their contact info along with their donations. These slips can either be dropped into each bottle or rubber-banded onto each bottle so that we can properly thank them. Then, one of your group leaders should encourage your members to take a bottle as they leave, letting them know the return deadline. You might have volunteers stationed at the exit doors to distribute the bottles as your members leave the kick-off.



This benefits the unborn and their parents by keeping our doors open to offer abortion alternatives!



Collecting & Giving Bottles

On days & weeks following your kick off you may like to have a friendly volunteer stationed next to the collection bassinette in a visible area each week to thank those who bring back their bottles & remind people of the upcoming deadline.

A bassinette can be borrowed from a member of your group or church, or are sometimes available from the center. Once collected, contact us for pick up or call the center nearest you to drop it off. We will count & roll all the coins before depositing the donations. Then, we will send your group a letter with the grand total & will tell of a specific family we have helped recently.

HELPFUL IDEAS

Baby Bottle showers can be done any time, including during VBS, missions emphasis time, given out on Mother's Day to be returned on Father's Day, during Sanctity of Life Month, during the holiday season, or in Sunday School classes.
